Process of Appointing (starting) Accountants in High Schools

1. Each major school/High school /Higher Secondary school should have one accountant.

- Donation Cash and kind (cloth, chair, sound system)
- Other collection Marriage, Baptism charges.
- Holy childhood, (church collection)

- Current expenses.
- Cooks, catechists.
- Other employees.
- House-building Maintenance.
- Donation/ charity
- News papers, periodicals, Books, Magazines.
- T. V.
- Any other.
- Audit Fee.
